Subject: **Remote and In-Person Learning Requests- January 2021**

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The Elmwood Park School District will continue to support the choices of all guardians to send their children for in-person instruction or to elect for total virtual learning. In order to facilitate all requests across the district, the administration has outlined a process to maintain social distancing and safety guidelines within every facility, and to ensure all students have full access to remote learning. Please see the below directions regarding remote learning, or return to hybrid instruction requests.

## **Students Currently Approved to Learn Remotely**

The parental requests that were **previously approved** for total remote instruction **DO NOT** have to fill out the below form if you wish to keep your child(ren) home for virtual learning. From this point forward, your remote request will be honored and your child(ren) will be designated as remote learners until a parent/guardian completes the below In-Person Learning Form, and is **approved to return to in-person learning**.

## **Requesting Total Remote Instruction from this Date Forward**

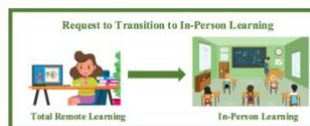


For those parents/guardians who have been sending their children into school for in-person learning but **would now like to request total remote instruction**, may enter this request by using the below Google Form. One form is needed for each child.

Again, parents who were previously approved for total remote instruction, **DO NOT** have to fill out the below form if you wish to keep your child(ren) home for virtual learning.

## **Requests to Return to In-Person Instruction**



For those parents who have **already been approved for total remote instruction**, you must formally **request to send your child back for in-person learning**. When you choose to send your child back to hybrid, in-person instruction, you may enter this request by completing the following Google Form:

**[Request to Transition to In-Person Learning](#)**

Please fill out this form only if you would like to transition your child from virtual instruction to in-person learning. One form is needed for each child.

**Reminders:**

- The district may require a period of 30 calendar days to process your request.
- Students who are approved as total remote learners will remain home until a Return to In-Person Learning form is completed and approved by the administration.
- All students, even those who are learning remotely, must complete the daily attestation form, found on the district website.
