Email from council liaison Francesco Fasolo, 179 Lee Street

Good Evening Everyone,

Firstly, on behalf of the Mayor and Council, I'd like to commend the district's teachers and staff for all they have done and are doing during this most difficult time we are facing. It is vital for our community that we have stability in education, and our teachers are doing an excellent job in ensuring everyone is getting the proper education.

My questions for the board are:

• According to reports on Governor Murphy's proposed budget, Elmwood Park School District is slated to receive about 2.5 Million Dollars in additional state aid. If this is the case, we would be the 3rd highest increase in Bergen County. With that said, will the board commit to using the money to offset any tax increase that the budget may have caused our residents?

Mr. Iachetti responded that the board has taken additional state aid received for the 2020-21 school year into consideration and as it stands now the general fund tax levy increase is proposed at 1%.

• Before schools reopen, can the board plan to disinfect all athletic equipment and playgrounds around the district? Many residents have voiced that concern.

Mr. Iachetti responded that as the district has all along we will continue to disinfect all athletic equipment. He stated further that the board has even assisted the town disinfected by sharing a resource it has so the town can disinfect their equipment and offices.

E mail from Jeanne Freitag, 35 Hillman Drive

I believe that the remote participation by the BOE members does not meet the standards which I forwarded to you yesterday. It clearly states the process for participation which it appears will not be happening at your meeting. You state that both you and Mr. DiPaola will be present in the Media Center. You do not state whether or not any board members will be in attendance. If any are voting remotely, I have sent you the procedures which have to be followed. This seems to be standard practice.

I would like to mention these requirements again - It is possible for a board member to participate in a meeting and vote remotely, for example by speaker phone, provided adequate

steps are taken to ensure that the public can hear the remote board member participate in the meeting and he or she can hear the other board members and members of the public. A board that wishes to allow remote voting should first adopt a policy to set forth the conditions and procedures under which it would be permitted. For example, it would not be appropriate for a majority of the members participating in a meeting to do so remotely. This is another topic where it is appropriate to consult with board counsel before acting.

I will not be able to attend tonight's meeting but I respectfully request that these words be read into the record

Mr. Iachettti responded that the NJDOE permits a BOE to meet remotely, however, they should have a central meeting space open to the public in order to comply with OPMA. The district feels we are following the state guidelines to hold a public meeting and having the board members participate via "Zoom" and a venue for public comments at the HS/MS in the usual meeting place, during the Coronavirus.
