Eligibility Requirements

(Division 1)

- ❖ In best 16 Core Courses, minimum core-course GPA of 2.300 is required.
- ❖ Core courses are academic courses such as English, math, science, history and world language.
- ❖ GPA Calculation: A = 4.0, B = 3.0, C = 2.0, D = 1.0
- ❖ 10 core courses are required before beginning of senior year for competition.
- ❖ 7 of the 10 core courses must be in English, math and science.

Eligibility Requirements (Cont.) (Division 1)

- ❖ Minimum score on SAT of 980 (*critical reading and math only).
- ❖ Minimum sum score of 75 on ACT required (Add English, math, reading and science sub scores).
- ❖ Graduate from high school.

Eligibility Requirements (Division 2)

- ❖ In best 16 Core Courses, minimum core-course GPA of 2.20 is required. (*New for 2018)
- ❖ Core courses are academic courses such as English, math, science, history and world language.
- ❖ GPA Calculation: A = 4.0, B = 3.0, C = 2.0, D = 1.0
- ❖ Minimum score of 920 on SAT (*critical reading and math only).
- ❖ Minimum sum score of 70 on ACT required English, math, reading and science).
- ❖ Graduate from high school.

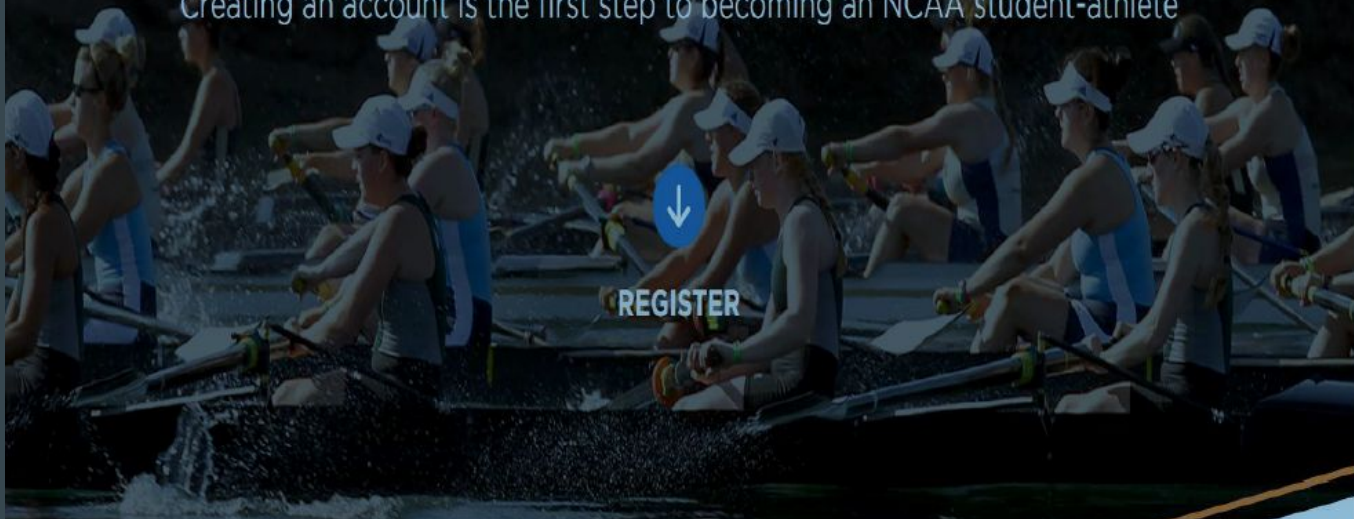

STEP 4: Submitting Student Transcripts

- ❖ See your guidance counselor in the guidance office to have your initial transcript sent to the NCAA Clearinghouse at the completion of your junior year.
- ❖ See your guidance counselor in the guidance office to have your final transcript sent to the NCAA Clearinghouse prior to June of your senior year.
