## Eligibility Requirements (Division 1)

In best 16 Core Courses, minimum core-course GPA of 2.300 is required.
Core courses are academic courses such as English, math, science, history and world language.
GPA Calculation: $\mathrm{A}=4.0, \mathrm{~B}=3.0, \mathrm{C}=2.0, \mathrm{D}=1.0$ 10 core courses are required before beginning of senior year for competition. 7 of the 10 core courses must be in English, math and science.

# Eligibility Requirements (Cont.) 

(Division 1)
Minimum score on SAT of 980 (*critical reading and math only).
Minimum sum score of 75 on ACT required (Add English, math, reading and science sub scores).
Graduate from high school.

## Eligibility Requirements

 (Division 2)* In best 16 Core Courses, minimum core-course GPA of 2.20 is required. (*New for 2018)

Core courses are academic courses such as English, math, science, history and world language. GPA Calculation: $\mathrm{A}=4.0, \mathrm{~B}=3.0, \mathrm{C}=2.0, \mathrm{D}=1.0$ Minimum score of 920 on SAT (* critical reading and math only).
Minimum sum score of 70 on ACT required English, math, reading and science).
Graduate from high school.
