To Parent Teacher & Employee Organizations:

The Elmwood Park Board of Education has contracted with EnviroVision Consultants Inc. to act as their "Designated Person" as defined under the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) of 1986. AHERA required that all educational facilities be inspected for asbestos – containing materials and develop a remedial plan of action on or before May 9, 1989. In addition, each educational facility shall reassess all identified asbestos – containing materials or materials assumed to be asbestos, at least once every six months (periodic surveillance) and re-inspect those facilities every three years (Triannual re-inspection).

The Elmwood Park Board of Education is in compliance with these requirements. The most recent Tri-annual re-inspection was performed in June 2019. The last "Periodic Surveillance" inspection was performed in June 2021 with the next one scheduled for December 2021.

Following each inspection, appropriate remedial actions are recommended to the Board of Education by an accredited Asbestos Management Planner. The remedial plans of action and recommended schedules for implementation (Asbestos Management Plans) are available for review at the Elmwood Park Board of Education Administrative Office, as well as in each school office.

This past year two asbestos abatement efforts were undertaken at the Memorial High School. The projects involved the removal of non-friable floor tile and mastic and were performed in accordance with all applicable State and Federal rules, regulations, and guidelines. The details of the projects can be viewed within the Asbestos Management Plan for the High School.

We will continue to keep you informed of our AHERA compliance.
