Several weeks ago, you received a letter that provided a preview regarding the district's upcoming English Language Arts and Mathematics Summer Learning Programs. It is now my pleasure to share with you some information regarding the new Summer S.T.E.A.M. Program, which will also be implemented by the district this summer.

The Summer S.T.E.A.M. Program will provide enrichment opportunities in Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Mathematics for students who are entering Grades 1 through 8 in September 2022 and are not enrolled in the district's other offerings, including the English Language Arts and Mathematics Summer Learning Programs.

The Summer S.T.E.A.M. Program will be held from 8:30 to 11:20 A.M., four days per week (Mondays through Thursdays), from June 27 through July 28, 2022. A brief break will be provided during each session. Two district locations will be utilized: Sixteenth Avenue Elementary School and Memorial Middle/High School. Please be advised that transportation will not be provided for students in attendance.
