

CRUpon System

How it works:

When a teacher sees you behaving in a positive way, you may be rewarded with a CRUpon. Some examples of reasons you may earn CRUpons include being respectful, following instructions, being on task, completing assignments, and any other positive aspect you are engaged in.

Two options to redeem CRUpons:

Trade in 10 CRUpons for an incentive. Students can go to the guidance office to see their counselor after school to trade in their CRUpons.

Students can place their CRUpons in the large Castle Box located in the main office where monthly drawings will occur and will be announced after morning announcements.
