There was a Work Meeting of the Elmwood Park Board of Education on Tuesday, June 25, 2013, at 6:30 p.m. in the Memorial Middle School Teachers' Cafeteria. Present were: Keith Cannizzo, Jeanne Freitag, Kathleen Policano, Arlene Rudmann, Peter Scolaro, Louise Gerardi, and Douglas DeMatteo. Stephen Zacone was absent from the Work Meeting. Jennifer Pellegrine was absent from the Work Meeting, but present for the Regular Meeting. Also present were Dr. Richard D. Tomko, Superintendent of Schools, Thomas Egan, State Monitor, William P. Moffitt, Board Secretary/Business Administrator, Patricia Otten, Confidential Executive Secretary, for the taking of minutes, and members of the public. The meeting was opened at 6:35 p.m.



For the record, Mrs. Freitag stated: "I am voting no on NI for a few reasons. There was progress but not as much as I would have liked. There are budget constraints and many new expenditures. A few years ago the teachers gave up 1 percent of the funds set aside for their raises in order to find the iPad initiative. Perhaps Dr. Tomko should have considered foregoing his raise as a sign of good faith to the district.

A recent example of good faith - Dr. Daniel Fishbein, Superintendent of Ridgewood, has accepted a \$50,000 pay cut upon the renewal of his contract. Although this cut was required, he chose to accept this reduction as a commitment to the students of Ridgewood".

For the Record Mrs. Gerardi stated: "I am voting yes for the merit pay because Dr. Tomko hit the bullet points that were set by the Board of Education and New Jersey School Boards. Back at the March meeting all nine of us voted and approved the resolution stating that the points were in, progress and being met...and since that time no one on the board of education had come forward to voice any concern about the points. People are trying to say that he should give up merit because of the deficit, but the deficit had nothing to do with the benchmarks of the merit. Our district being in a deficit would be put into Dr. Tomko's personnel file as a red mark, but the deficit was not correlated to the merit".






